Dear Ms. Hubbard Krimmer,

I am writing to update you on the status of your Ontario Employment Assistance Services (OEAS) agreement with the Ministry of Training, Colleges and Universities (Ministry).

Earlier this year, the Ministry and your organization amended your organization's agreement to extend the term to March 31, 2011.

The Ministry is engaged in further study on program design as it continues to transform the Employment Ontario network.

Until this process is completed, the Ministry is inviting your organization to continue delivering the same services to clients from April 1, 2011 to March 31, 2012 under a new OEAS agreement. This impacts your organization's current agreement, noted below:

- Agreement 3593431 for London

The Ministry will not be negotiating an amendment to your current agreement to extend the expiry date. Instead, your organization will be offered a new agreement that meets provincial government transfer payment accountability standards. The activities will be the same as those set out in your current agreement.

A Ministry staff person will contact you shortly to review the details of this letter.


Once you have had an opportunity to discuss your organization's details with regional staff, you will be asked to confirm in writing with your regional contact by October 31, 2010 whether your organization accepts the Ministry's invitation to continue delivering current services.

Please note that this letter indicates the status of your organization for Western Region only. If your organization has OEAS agreement(s) in other regions, you will receive a letter from the Regional Director of that region to advise you of the status of those agreements.
